Thanksgiving Offering—This year we have identified two ministries that will be the main recipients of our Thanksgiving Offering. **The first is Esperanza Hope Costa Rica Mission trip.** We have committed as a church to send a team of 10 to Costa Rica with a shipment of 194 wheelchairs and covering the associated \$32,500 in expenses. **The second**

is to assist the Heytsi family. They have recently adopted 3 children, taken in Vasya's mother, and considering the possibility of adopting a newborn. For more information on either of these missions, please see this month's Maurice Moments. *Again, this year the mission budget is in a deficit*. Any funds designated to the mission budget will help with this. If you are considering giving to another charity through the church, remember many charities are already non-profit organizations that can give you the same tax benefit as giving through the church. Also, our classical assessments are based on total church revenue so giving to another non-profit will increase the assessment amount that our church pays to the classis.


