Sunday school will be starting up soon! Please follow the directions below:

- 3-year old's through kindergarten will continue to go to Room 9 for a time of singing. Please bring your child there as soon as the service is over! After singing, they will go to their classrooms. Parents, please pick your child up from their classroom at 11:30.
- 1st grade—3rd grade students will go directly to the multipurpose room for a short teaching time, then head to their classrooms until 11:15 when they will return to the multipurpose room for a time of singing! Parents, please pick your child up at the multipurpose room at 11:30.
- 4th-5th grade students will go directly to room 22 when the service is over. They will have their lesson and then go to their classrooms. They will join the 1st-3rd grade students in the multipurpose room for a time of singing at 11:15. Parents, please pick your children up from the multipurpose room at 11:30

Class lists and room assignments will be posted on the wall by Room 4. Please double check where your child will be as some have changed.



Awana - Awana will be starting up soon! Check in beings at 6:00 pm. If your child is staying in the same group, please have them wear their vest/shirt that night. If they are advancing to the next leveled group and you registered by the deadline, a new vest/shirt will be available for them. Also, all students that were registered by the deadline will receive their workbook to take to and from Awana each week.

Students will need to provide their own cinch sack or backpack to carry their things to Awana each week. Inside this bag will include their handbook, Bible, pencil, offering, and envelope for the Awana Bucks. At check-in, kids will get Awana Bucks for having everything along each night!
