

PRAYING PELICAN MISSIONS Sr. High Summer Mission Trip – June 21-29, 2024 - We are excited for our Sr. High summer mission trip will be Whitesburg, Kentucky. Whitesburg is a small town of nearly 1,700 people in the valley of the North Fork of the Kentucky River, surrounded by mountains. Due to the decline of the coal industry over the years, almost 25% of families live under the poverty line. While in Whitesburg, we will stay at First Baptist Church. We will have the opportunity to serve in a variety of ways: physical labor, construction, and ministering to children and youth. This community was on national news two summers ago as flooding caused large amounts of destruction and loss. We will help with their rebuilding efforts. We look forward to God using us to be a blessing, and no doubt be blessed along the way as well. The cost is \$250 per person and is due now; checks written out to MRC Sr. High. Currently there are 42 students & 8 leaders registered.
