Important Update - Church Key Fobs



Thoughts on Why Theology Belongs in the Preschool Room

When it comes to teaching young children, theology might seem like a concept that's too complex for them to grasp. After all, preschoolers are still learning basic concepts like colors, shapes, and counting. However, introducing solid biblical truths to preschool-aged kids is not only possible—it's essential.

So let's talk about why theology belongs in the preschool room and how to teach it in a way that is both age-appropriate and impactful! By laying the foundation for deep spiritual understanding early on, you'll help build a strong, lasting faith in the hearts of the next generation.

Preschoolers Are Spiritually Curious

Young children are naturally curious about the world, including spiritual concepts. They're already forming ideas about right & wrong, love, and God. Teaching basic truths like "God loves you" and "Jesus is our friend" gives them building blocks for future faith. Preschoolers can understand more than we think—use simple but meaningful language.

Theology Helps Kids Know Who God Is

At its core, theology is learning who God is. Preschoolers can begin to understand God's goodness, power, and love through stories, songs, and play.

--God as Creator: Show them that God made the world --God's Love: Teach that God loves them no matter what.

Theology Lays a Gospel Foundation

It's never too early to introduce the gospel. Teach kids:
--God made us and loves us.
--Sin hurt our relationship with Him.
--Jesus came to fix it because He loves us.

Keep It Simple and Focused

Stick to one clear truth at a time, using visuals and repetition. Keep lessons short and engaging—show a picture of animals and say, "God made all of this because He loves it!"

The key is to share God's love and His truth. Kids are always watching and learning, led by our example. Impacting children with the gospel helps them build a foundation of faith. Children and Worship is a great way of providing a time for our little people to learn about God at their level of understanding.
