Sub Sandwich Fundraiser Update - Thanks so much to all the parents, leaders, and kids for making this year's sub sale a huge success! Church Key Fobs - We have installed a key fob system that will be used to access the church buildings after hours. The church building will be open during the week when staff is present, as well as during Sunday services, Wednesday Night Activities, and other church sponsored events. If you need access to the building outside of those times (praise team practice, a Bible study that meets at church, Sunday school teacher, committee member, etc.), you may request a fob by filling out the form that you should have received in your church mailbox (there are extra at the information table).
