



Faith Without Filters: A View from Our Living Room



This last semester we chose to do the Bible study called **Rooted**, hoping it would give the college students that attend Bible study each week a firm foundation of what the Christian faith entails. What we didn't realize was how much we would be changed by the process.

Each week, as we gather, we see something rare in today's young people: **absolute authenticity**. Moving Beyond the Surface In a culture dominated by social media and cell phones, these students are exhausted by "perfect." They are hungry for a faith that is open, honest, and even a little messy. Through the Rooted study, we have watched them:

- **Share Deeply:** They aren't holding back. From mental health struggles to deep questions about Scripture, no topic is off-limits.
- **Build True Bonds:** Because they are willing to be vulnerable, they have formed a support system that goes far beyond a typical Bible study.
- **Seek the "Why":** They aren't satisfied with "just because." They want to know how the Gospel intersects with their daily lives.

Lessons from the Next Generation

People often worry about the future generation, but sitting across from these young adults, we truly feel nothing but hope. In many ways, **they have become our teachers**. They remind us each week that God doesn't need us to have it all together; He just wants us to be present and honest. Their hunger for the Word has reignited our own, and their courage to share their "deep things" has challenged us to live more authentically ourselves.

Special Offering Opportunity for March & April: The Gospel Mission of Sioux City

"The Gospel Mission exists to feed the hungry, clothe the poor, shelter the homeless, to lead them to Christ. The Mission has served 3 meals a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year for 85 years. Our Mission Kitchen serves hot meals to our shelter residents, and in addition, serves meals to other homeless individuals and community members who are in need. Our Food pantry regularly serves 50+ family units each day, where they can pick out a variety of food items, including canned foods, fresh produce and baked goods."

They also have a thrift store, men's shelter, and women and children's rehabilitation shelters.



"While the part about 'leading them to Christ' is the last piece of our mission statement, it is our primary goal for all parts of our daily operations. We offer 2 chapel/devotion times each day, and require all residents to attend at least one session each day. Our women shelter residents regularly attend a local church. We hire only staff who can attest to our Statement of Christian Faith and Biblical definition of Marriage and Sexuality agreement. I've personally seen our staff reach out purposefully to mentor residents 1:1. Relationships are so very important to helping someone see their need for a Savior!"


