CONSISTORY MEETING NOTES MARCH 9, 2026

- Leadership Cohort Update - Pastor Jeremy and Steve Vis had their last meeting with this ministry. What they learned is we have to raise up leaders and send them out.
- Financial report was presented

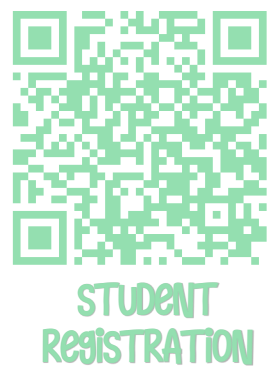


VBS Volunteers Needed

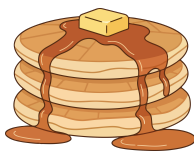

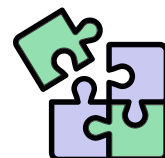

SPECIAL OFFERING OPPORTUNITY FOR MARCH & APRIL: THE GOSPEL MISSION OF SIOUX CITY

"The Gospel Mission exists to feed the hungry, clothe the poor, shelter the homeless, to lead them to Christ. The Mission has served 3 meals a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year for 85 years. Our Mission Kitchen serves hot meals to our shelter residents, and also serves meals to other homeless individuals & community members who are in need. Our Food pantry regularly serves 50+ family units each day, where they can pick out a variety of food items, including canned foods, fresh produce & baked goods."

They also have a thrift store, men's shelter, and women and children's rehabilitation shelters.

"While the part about 'leading them to Christ' is the last piece of our mission statement, it is our primary goal for all parts of our daily operations. We offer 2 chapel/devotion times each day, and require all residents to attend at least one session each day. Our women shelter residents regularly attend a local church. We hire only staff who can attest to our Statement of Christian Faith & Biblical definition of Marriage and Sexuality agreement. I've personally seen our staff reach out purposefully to mentor residents 1:1. Relationships are so very important to helping someone see their need for a Savior!" -- Randy Ehlers Executive Director

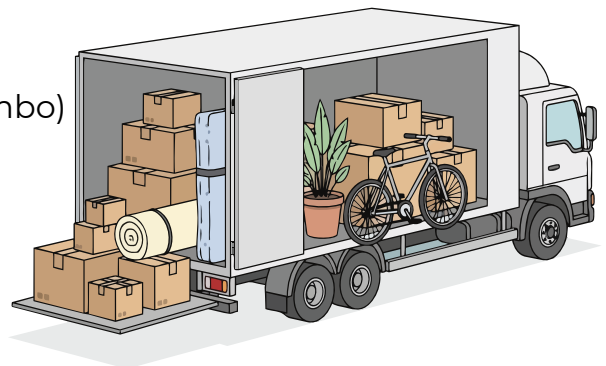


FURNITURE DRIVE FOR MISSIONARIES

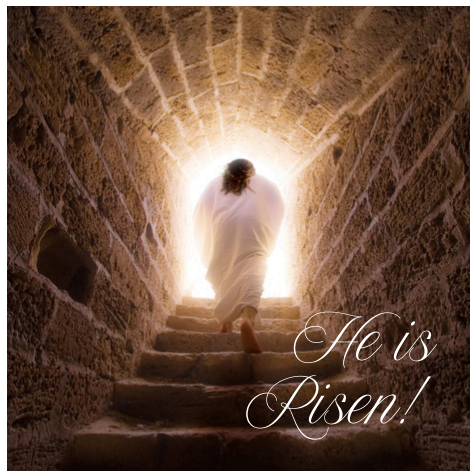
