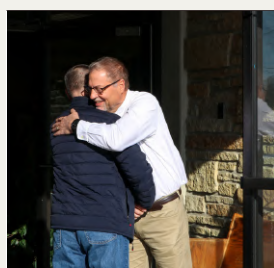
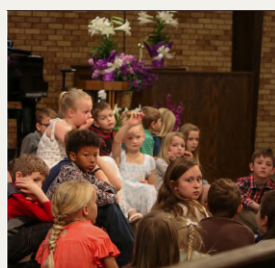
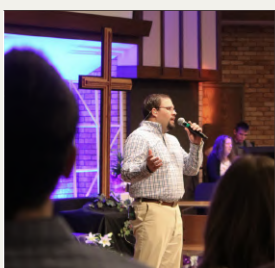

CONSISTORY REPORT

CONSISTORY MEETING NOTES APRIL 13, 2026

- Pastor Jeremy called the meeting to order. He then led us in devotions about how things happen for a reason and getting to know others through discipleship.
- The consistory then discussed Core Value #7 which is to address issues when made aware of them.
- Pastor Jeremy explained to the Deacons how the Profession of Faith process will happen in the future.
- Financial report was given
 - M/S/C to approve the financial report as given.
- Search Team Reports:
 - Dwight has officially started his position as Worship Coordinator and is getting acquainted with people. Shellie is willing to voluntarily help with Dwight's transition. A BIG thank you to Shellie for her help with service coordination during our vacant time.
 - Youth Search Team is currently putting out advertisements again for the Youth Pastor position. Karlee Hofmeyer and Tegegn Smit have shown interest in doing a summer internship again this year.
- Strategic Team reported that they are getting together every 2 weeks at first to get things moving. They are currently doing and exploring various media venues.
- Core Value Team Time:
 - Music and Worship is very appreciative of the work Shellie put in for the interim time between worship coordinators. They are looking at upgrading the sound board in the future and stage boxes as well. Mike made and donated back stage storage cupboards.
 - Discipleship Team went over VBS plans, looking at 55+ program, looking into summer interns for youth, looking at possible Young Marrieds Sunday School class in the future, checking into next year's youth sponsors.
 - Service/Mission Team hoping to get new roof on FLC this summer, new furnace and air conditioner installed in parsonage, changed insurance carriers and got a savings of \$24,000. Concerning the Ukrainian families, we had a \$10,000 donation to cover this asking and the remaining amount was taken out of Deacon Benevolence fund.
 - Congregational Life Team sent out questionnaire to Life Group leaders to find out who is involved in Life Groups so they know who needs a care provider. Still looking for more care providers at this time.
 - Admin Team discussed having next consistory meeting on May 11th and Congregational Meeting will be May 17th immediately after morning service. Consistory meeting will be June 15th for new consistory members. We have a full slate of Elders & Deacons.
 - M/S/C to approve double slate of Elders & Deacons as presented.

- M/S/C to adjourn after prayer by Pastor Jeremy

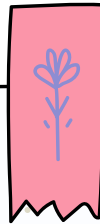

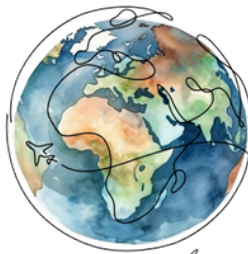

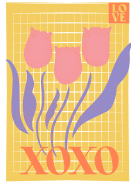
