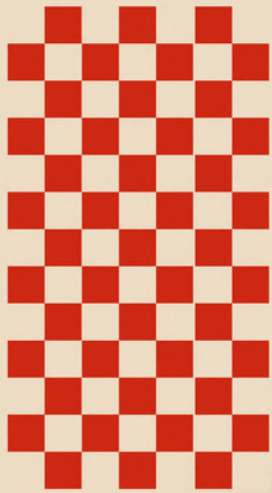

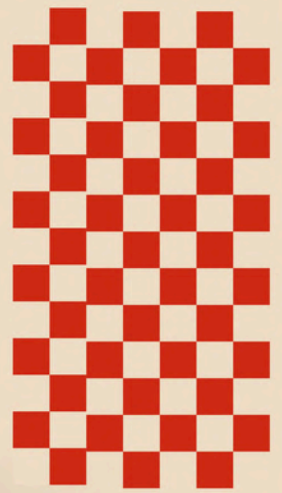

CONSISTORY REPORT

CONSISTORY MEETING NOTES AUGUST 17, 2026

- Pastor Jeremy opened the meeting in prayer before the 6:00 PM meal.
- **Community Prayer - 6:30 PM**
 - **Consistory prayed over the following 10 items:**
 - Students and parents
 - Farmers preparing for harvest
 - YMT and youth leaders
 - Ministry Fair - August 30
 - Intergenerational Team and discernment
 - Sunday School leaders and teachers
 - Wisdom for Consistory
 - Unity in the church
 - Health concerns and those who are mourning
 - Staff and continued leadership in their positions
- At 7:00 PM, Elders and Deacons met separately. Consistory reconvened at 8:00 PM.
- **Intergenerational Team Presentation**
 - Pastor Jeremy shared Proverbs 15:22: "Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed," noting that the Intergenerational Team has followed this principle. He then opened in prayer and invited the team to present their survey findings.
 - Rob Hofmeyer introduced the team's goals and findings. The team presented their slideshow and explained how the survey connected with three core value teams: Worship, Discipleship, and Congregational Care.
 - A link to the survey, questions and answers, and slideshow will be sent to Marc to share with Consistory.
- **Financial Report**
 - Following the Intergenerational Team's presentation, Pastor Jeremy reviewed the financial report. Eric C. moved to approve the report, Evan supported, and the motion passed.
- **Other Discussions and Updates**
 - **Benji Cotter:** Consistory discussed communication with Benji, how he is doing, continued contact, and prayer.
 - **Connection Teams:** Steve Vis distributed the Connection Team list and discussed contacting individuals from last month's list, including possible conversation starters and questions. Pictures of members can be provided if needed, and Elders are available to help with conversations.
 - **Gifts & Passions:** Pastor Jeremy revisited the Gifts & Passions document from the previous meeting. The group agreed to present this to the congregation on the Sunday following Labor Day.
 - **Discipleship:** The team will meet Wednesday evening with YMT and leaders from Jr. GAP and Sr. High.
 - **Service/Missions:** No update.
 - **Congregational Care:** An update was given regarding additional people moving into care homes. The shut-in list for communion and visits will be updated. Bonnie Wolf also mentioned the possibility of bringing a Christian comedian to MRC for a fellowship event, pending approval.
 - **Staff:** Staff discussed having a fellowship night the first weekend of October.
 - **Worship:** The team discussed feedback Dwight is requesting regarding worship services and an upcoming AV booth update. Justin Schrock reminded Consistory about the 2nd Sunday evening Worship & Prayer service and the 4th Sunday evening worship service led by Pastor Jeremy.
 - **Christmas Services:** Justin asked about Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services; this will be discussed further by the Elders at their breakfast.

- The October Consistory meeting was moved to Tuesday, October 13, due to Pastor Jeremy being gone the third Monday. The change was agreed upon.
- Consistory discussed having each Core Value Team meet with the Intergenerational Team and bring that discussion back to the next Consistory meeting.
- Phil suggested sending a thank-you/acknowledgment to the YMT and Intergenerational Team for their service.

- Pastor Jeremy moved to approve the minutes; the motion was supported and approved.
- Pastor Jeremy then moved to adjourn following prayer. The motion was supported and passed.

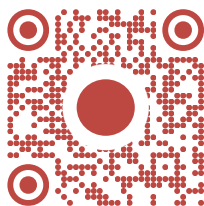

Truly it was more than Deb or I ever thought was possible as we returned to Cambodia as newlyweds in 1995 or again in 2010 as we returned after spending four formative years in Holland, MI.



Friends, while this continues to be an emotional time for me, I have come to understand that this is not the end, rather it is the next chapter as we trust in the Lord, acknowledging Him in all our ways and walking the path which He sets before us. For some of you that might be a shift to another region or people group. For others, it might be a shift from supporting the missionary in Cambodia to supporting the Ministry in Cambodian. In truth, that is what many of you have been doing for many years, for which we are grateful for your partnership! For those with such a vision to continue supporting the PPBS ministry, there is a 501(c)(3) organization based in the US called Able to Teach which can help you do that "directly.
