CHILDREN'S MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

We're excited about the ministry year and want to make sure every child has opportunities to learn, grow, and connect as they grow in their faith! Here are some of the ways children can be involved at MRC:

- **Nursery – Sundays:** During both the worship service and Sunday School, nursery is available for children 2 and under. It's a place where little ones can be cared for, play, and interact with other children, students, and adults.
- **Children & Worship – 1st & 3rd Sundays:** Beginning in October, children ages 3–4 will have the opportunity to participate in Children & Worship during the service. They will be dismissed during the offering for a special time designed just for them. They will be taken straight to Sunday School afterwards, so parents can pick up their kids after Sunday School.
- **Sunday School – Sundays, 10:45–11:30 AM:** Sunday School begins with singing before children head into age-based groups to learn and grow together as they dig into God's Word.
- **Quest & EE – Wednesdays:** Quest is for children 4th grade and younger and includes singing, Scripture, activities, and small-group time. EE is specifically for 5th graders, teaching them the gospel and how to share it with others.
